November 10, 2018 – Final Winter Preparations



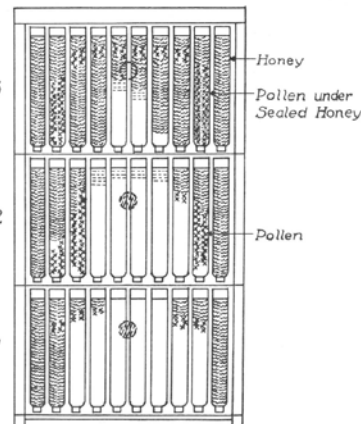
Total Cost: \$195
